

Present Enrollment: 303 girls and 259 boys = 562 **students**.



Results of GSAT over a 3-year period




The graph above indicates that in 2008 the GSAT results were reflecting 62%.

In 2009 it has declined to 47% because of the location of the Grade 6 classes.

In 2010 the performance increased to 50% as a result of relocating the classes to a more conducive area.
